Regular Meeting

June 5, 2013

Supervisor Slee called the regular monthly meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Deputy Clerk Masters presented the Board with an update on the Fire and Ambulance. Total runs for the year: Fire 168 and Ambulance 160.

Trustee Brehm reported that the Planning Commission met on May 15 to discuss changes to the Master Plans Land Use contract. Brian Wegener will present changes at next planning meeting. Items discussed were bike paths, streets, Shaftsbury and rural character.

Meeting was reconvened due to arrival of Shiawassee County Prosecuting Attorney, Deanna Finnegan. She provided the board with status of crime in Woodhull Township.
