

# TOWNSHIP OF WOODHULL

Special Meeting/Workshop

October 10, 2017

Supervisor Nickols started the workshop session with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were: Betts, Jelenek, Maize and Nickols. Absent was Slee.

Meeting was call by Supervisor Nickols to revisit the township road funding and how it is determined on what roads are to be allocated for funding. In response to one of the statements made by the Treasurer in her written comments to be read aloud regarding notification of board members let it be known that once the day and time was established each member was notified on Saturday night. Impact of 80/20 resolution was not intent of hearing. As requested, Treasurer's Slee comments were read and will be placed in the minute's book for all to review. Synopsis of comments pertained to the 80/20 which was not discussed.

Supervisor Nickols handed out several copies of reports that showed Township miles of 2017, Subdivision tax information and Revenue and Expenditures. This was to get a better understanding of the number of roads involved along with subdivisions for expenditures.

Trustee Jelenek will be forming a committee to review all input involving the different roads and the committee will then make recommendation to bring to the Board for review. This committee will be actively working towards making a better and more feasible solution as to how the Township can maintain and fix all the roads in the Township in which to set a fair and just policy. Jelenek stated that Mike Bachelder and Beverly Lang along with himself would make up the committee and that anyone else interested would be more than welcomed.

It was concurred that it is time to set aside differences and move forward and with the help of the committee, public and Board this can be accomplished.
