PROHIBITION OF ALL MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE

An ordinance to provide a title for the ordinance; to define words; to prohibit all marihuana establishments within the boundaries of **WOODHULL TOWNSHIP** pursuant to Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951; (h) "Marihuana establishment" means a marihuana grower, marihuana safety compliance facility, marihuana processor, microbusiness 'marihuana retailer', marihuana secure transporter, or any other type of marihuana-related business licensed by the department: to provide penalties for violation of this ordinance; to provide for severability; to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith; and to provide an effective date.

ORDAINS

SECTION 1

TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as and may be cited as the **WOODHULL TOWNSHIP PROHIBITION OF ALL MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE.**

SECTION II

DEFINITIONS

Words used herein shall have the definitions as provided for in Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 *et seq.*, as may be amended.

SECTION III

NO MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS

WOODHULL TOWNSHIP hereby prohibits all marihuana establishments within the boundaries of the township pursuant to initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 *et seq.;* (h) "Marihuana establishment" means a marihuana grower, marihuana grower, marihuana safety compliance facility, marihuana processor, microbusiness 'marihuana retailer', marihuana secure transporter, or any other type of marihuana-related business by the department, as may be amended.

SECTION IV

VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

- Any person who neglects or refuses to comply with a provision of this ordinance or who
 causes allows or consents to any of the same shall be deemed to be responsible for the
 violation of this ordinance. A violation of this ordinance is deemed to be a nuisance per
 se.
- 2. A violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infraction, for which the fines shall not be less than \$100 nor more than \$500, in the discretion of the Court. The foregoing sanctions shall be in addition to the rights of the Township to proceed at law or equity with other appropriate and proper remedies. Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Township incurs in connection with the municipal civil infraction.
- 3. Each day during which any violation continues shall be deemed a separate offence.
- 4. In addition, the township may seek injunctive relief against persons alleged to be in violation of this ordinance, and such other relief as may be provided by law.
- 5. This ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the Ordinance Enforcement Officer of the township or by such other person (s) as designated by the Township Board from time to time.

SECTION V

SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section, provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court

of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION VI

REPEAL

All ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII

EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.
