There are 540 drains in Shiawassee County and some are interacting with other counties. County and Township pays 20% each for drains and 60% is payed by the residents that are effected by drains on their property.

- b. <u>Planning Commission Rick Betts</u> no meeting due to lack of agenda but did updated the board on the special use permit 16-14, Prolime Ag Services by Robert Rogers. Going to the County Zoning Board of Appeals on April 12, 2017 at the Surbeck Building in Corunna, Michigan.

- c. Road Projects 2017-18 Discussed. Scratch/chip seal Woodbury Road from Lansing Road south to Ingham County Line, Gravel for Beardslee Road from Britton north to hared portion with Perry Township, Winegar Road from north leg of Laingsburg Road to Woodbury, Laingsburg Road from Winegar Road north to Sciota Township line and Peacock Road from Cutler Road to Clinton County Line. Mineral Well Brine #4 two wide continuous application. Pam asked to recuse herself from voting on the roads due to conflict of interest. Clerk Maize moved to recuse Slee. No support. Motion dropped. Trustee Jelenek moved and supported by Trustee Betts to do the road projects discussed. Roll call vote taken. Jelenek, yes; Nickols, yes; Maize, yes; Betts, yes and Slee, abstained.
