Paula made the motion to accept the minutes as written. Cathy seconded. Motion carried.

Woodhull Township Board Trustee Tom Jelenek brought some information to our board regarding decisions made concerning the Park Budget. There are numerous competing interests for budget dollars – Election board Requirements, Road Improvements, Building Updates, Technology Updates, Update Communication Network and Revenue Sharing Reduction. In the future, he asked that we consider making some changes that would bring some revenue into the park. Township Board would like Park Board to use the Savings Account Balance for budgeted items. Because of these considerations, the Park Board budget for 2020-2021 is \$11,400.00 which is down from \$29,800.00 in 2019-2020. In future budget planning, the Township Board would like the Park Board to provide data of proposed use, look at plans to initiate developments in stages and share plans and strategy for improvements and implementation in advance. We appreciate Tom coming to our meeting and supplying information for us to consider in the future.

Cathy made a motion that we ask our mowing service to mow every 10 days instead of weekly to cut costs for the summer. Cindy seconded. Motion carried.

Fred will contact One Way Asphalt and have them come out to walk path with Fred and determine parts of the path that are in the worst shape and have those fixed this year.

Jerry Bawks would be available to help with tree take down and clean up if necessary.

Cathy made a motion that we cut the service with Tru-Green to only vegetation spray and not other services. Paula seconded. Motion carried.

An item tabled for discussion later was whether to allow non-residents to reserve pavillions.

Our next meeting is scheduled for June 8, 2020.
