## SUMMER TAX COLLECTION 2021

The tax information for Woodhull Township residents is available online. It can be accessed through [www.bsasoftware.com](http://www.bsasoftware.com). We also have our online tax payments service that allows residents to pay property taxes online with a credit card or electronic check! Information is posted on our website [www.woodhulltwp.org](http://www.woodhulltwp.org) and click on Property Tax Information. Please note a fee DOES apply for this service. All tax bills are being mailed to property owners ONLY. It is the property owner's responsibility to forward or contact their own mortgage company. Taxes may be paid by mail or by leaving payment in the drop box next to the office door or by online Credit Card! Please enclose tax notice (top half) and check, money order, or bank draft made out to WOODHULL TOWNSHIP TREASURER and mailed to PO Box 166, Shaftsburg, MI 48882. No receipt will be sent unless requested with enclosed self-addressed return envelope. POSTMARK DATES do not serve as payment dates. Taxes are due September 14, 2021 and must be in my office by 5:00 pm or penalty and interest will be charged.

If you would like to pay your taxes in person I will be in my office, hours posted above. If you pay in cash, please have the correct amount. DO NOT LEAVE CASH IN THE DROP BOX.

Applications for deferment of summer taxes are available in my office and on the website. If you are eligible it must be filed in my office by September 14, 2021. Summer taxes cover July 1 of this year to June 30<sup>th</sup> of next year.
