Accomplishments:

Water samples were taken. All samples came back good except for the bacteria at the lower well. That well was chlorinated and samples did not pass again. It has been chlorinated a second time and waiting for sampling.

Trugreen has treated the fields a second time. There will be one final treatment will be done in September.

Cleaned up around the upper pavilion where the yard hydrant had been and removed the concrete pad,

Took water samples to Howell for testing.

The playground inspection was completed and there were no repairs needed.

A bees nest was removed from the soffit at the lower pavilion.

The oil and filter was changed on the John Deere.

Timbers and wood chips were add around the team benches at the west ball field.

Went to Costco for gas twice.

A stump grinder was rented and several stumps were removed.

The oil and filter were changed on the zero turn.

New blades were purchased and installed for the zero turn.

Trimmed along the fence at the entrance to the park.

Goals:

Timbers and wood chips are still needed at the east ball field.

The retaining wall needs to be built.

The brush along the path needs to be trimmed back.

The new musical instrument has to be installed.

Install 4x4 posts around the two wells.

Discussion/action item:

The cost to remove the hand pump at the upper pavilion.
