Accomplishments:

Worked on the forms to pour concrete for the upper pavilion faucet splash pad.
Installed 2) 4x4 posts to protect the well head at the upper pavilion.
The edge of the path around the upper park was mowed.
The brush was trimmed back around all of the paths and mowed areas.
New blades were purchased for the zero turn.
The water samples came back negative for bacteria for the lower well. The water was turned back on.
Timbers and wood chips were put under the east field benches.
I went to Home Depot for supplies for the retaining wall.
The retaining wall has been installed.
Wood chips were added to the musical instrument area.
A stump grinder was rented and several stumps were ground throughout the park. All the areas where the stumps were ground were leveled.
Fifteen trees were down or damaged from the severe storm we had August 27.
The park was closed from then until Friday, Sept. 6.
Equipment was rented and Bill, Kreg and I cleaned it all up.
A huge number of branches were cleaned up throughout the park.

Goals:

The new musical instrument will be installed.
The concrete will be poured for the area by the faucet at the upper pavilion.
One 4x4 will be installed by the well head at the lower pavilion.
