NOTICE OF AMBULANCE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT HEARINGS TO REAFFIRM SPECIAL
AMBULANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT; TO CONSIDER OBJECTIONS TO THE
DISTRIBUTION OF THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT LEVY; AND TO CONFIRM THE
ASSESSMENT ROLL

To: The Residents and Property Owners of the Township of Woodhull, Shiawassee County, Michigan,
and Other Interested Persons:

The Township Board has estimated the cost and expenses for providing ambulance, motor vehicles, personnel, equipment and housing, in order to provide ambulance protection, and accordingly the day has been fixed for hearing on the cost and on the question of reaffirming the Township-wide Special Assessment District, and to approve and accept the Special Assessment per household of \$230.02 per year; and to distribute the Special Assessment Levy so as to defray the expenses of providing such ambulance service by Special Assessment on the property to be especially benefitted. Said levy is in the total amount of \$365,513.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 13, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., there will be a Public Hearing at the Woodhull Township Hall located at 7315 West Beard Road, Perry, Michigan 48872, to consider reaffirming the Ambulance Special Assessment District which encompasses all of Woodhull Township; to approve and accept the Ambulance Special Assessment of \$230.02 each year against each residential household within Woodhull Township; to consider objections to the distribution of the Special Assessment Levy; and to approve the Assessment Roll.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 13, 2023, at 6:30 p.m., there will be a Public Hearing at the Woodhull Township Hall located at 7315 West Beard Road, Perry, Michigan 48872, to Spread the Levy of the Ambulance Special Assessment costs.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that there will be no other Public Hearing on this matter until noticed on by the Township in future years.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that appearance and protest at this hearing is required in order to appeal the amount of Special Assessment to the State Tax Tribunal, if an appeal shall be desired. A property owner or part in interest, or his or her agent, may appear in person at the hearing to protest the Special Assessment or may file his or her Appearance by letter, delivered to the Clerk, by mail or in person, by 6:00 p.m. on November 13, 2024, and his or her personal Appearance shall not be required. The property owner or any person having an interest in the property subject to the proposed Special Assessment may file a written appeal of the Special Assessment with the State Tax Tribunal within thirty (30) days of the Special Assessment Roll, if that Special Assessment was protested at this hearing.

At said hearing, the Woodhull Township Board will consider any written objection to any of the foregoing matters which might be filed with said Board, at or prior to the time of said hearing, as well as any revisions, corrections, amendments and/or suggestions.

All interested persons are invited to be present at the aforesaid time and place, and may submit comments on any of the foregoing.
